Action Contre la Faim (ACF) was founded in 1979 by a group of French intellectuals in response to the emergency in Afghanistan. While the fight against hunger had previously been an element of more general humanitarian action (the fight against poverty, promoting better health, etc.) they founded an organisation that was exclusively dedicated to ending hunger.

Since 1995, ACF has developed within the framework of an interdependent international network: ACF-International (ACF-IN) to better respond to the needs of populations.

ACFIN intervenes in the following situations:

- In natural or man-made crises which threaten food security or result in famine,
- In situations of social / economic breakdown, linked to internal or external circumstances which place particular groups of people in an extremely vulnerable position,
- In situations where survival depends on humanitarian aid.

ACF is responsible for its environmental impact and presents its approach to working in the context of the climate crisis.

ACF supports the objectives of the Paris Agreement from COP21 to keep the global average temperature increase below 2°C above pre- industrial levels, by adopting a strategy aimed at limiting warming to 1.5°C, and committing to a carbon- neutral society by 2050, with an initial reduction of its carbon footprint by 50% before 2030, in line with IPCC recommendations.

ACF places climate among its priorities and undertakes environmentally responsible actions within the scope of its mandate: fighting hunger worldwide.

ACF is transparent, accountable, and consistent in transforming its operations to address the climate crisis.

ACFIN is now recognized as one of the leading organisations in the fight against hunger worldwide.

The objective of this International Call for Tenders is to solicit competitive offers from reliable and specialized manufacturers and distributors for the supply of medicines, medical equipment, and associated services, so that ACFIN can treat and prevent malnutrition. The associated services include transport, storage, laboratory testing, research partnerships, etc.

The objective is to sign Framework Agreements with one or several manufacturers for 2 years. These contracts may then be extended two (2) times one (1) year.
