Tenders opening session will be held at CESVI office in Bergamo on 22/08/2026 at 11:00, in the presence of bidder's representatives (only one representative from each bidder), who wish to witness the tender opening. All Agents representing foreign companies should have a signed mandate from the companies being represented.
3. Tender evaluation session will be held on behind closed doors.
4. Tender Committee reserve the right to increase/decrease the quantity of supplies after award of tender to the tender winner.

Bidder must not be engaged in any corruption, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices including but not limited to applying/bidding by multiple names/companies or submitting a fake call deposit/earnest money.
